

Dear Council, Administration & Distinguished Guests

Sometimes important decisions are made and I feel its important to understand where we have been and how we have gotten there before we decide where or which direction we are going.

Extensive research has been done using resources such as Council Minutes, both RM (1) and (2) Town, (3) Saskatchewan Regional Park Authority, Willow Bunch Park Board (4) Ministry of Parks, Culture & Sport, (5), (6), (7) Honourable Laura Ross current minister, as well as History books and good old google search.

Interestingly enough I am about to share with you some dates, names, and figures that were all instrumental in getting us here today.

On Monday July 24th, 1961 the Executive Council of the Province of Saskatchewan had under consideration a report from the Minister of Natural Resources, dated July 18th, 1961 that formed the basis of naming the Jean Louis Legare Regional Park Authority allowing it to establish and operate a regional park in the vicinity of Willow Bunch. That same Executive order named the following persons and authorized them to act on behalf of both participating municipalities (Town & RM of Willow Bunch No. 42).

Interestingly enough this formalizes the Park, however its beginning along with Golf Course are reported in the History book as having begun years earlier. Understandably, so, the purchase of the lands would have been the biggest factor.

It was reported that Albert Mainil, James (Jim) Patterson, Jim Gibson, James Porter and Laurent Deblois would canvass the community asking for \$50.00 from each person and were successful in raising the money to purchase the quarter of land at \$4000.00 from the Co-op farm. Keep in mind the average the average hourly salary in 1959 (stats

Canada) was \$1.88 male, \$1.11 female, which equates to \$3910.40 per annum male and \$2308.80 female.

Suffice it to say relative land prices to annual salaries equated throughout normal times.

I'd like to emphasize that this \$50 donation equated to a monthly grocery bill or a trip to the city which included transportation, lodging and some shopping for the average family. \$50.00 then equates to \$437.43 today.

My point being that if \$4000 was raised at \$50/person it took 80 families to sacrifice those amenities. Average size of families in rural Saskatchewan in 1959 (Married couples accounted for 90.1% of the population. Women had nearly 3.9 children on average.) Source stats Canada.

Therefore families consisting of five people, times 80 families equals 400 people contributing financially with sacrifice to the purchase of the one quarter on the golf course.

Then came the arduous tasks of building it. This adds another lengthy list of workers, students and volunteers.

Improvements to both the Park and Golf Course continued throughout the years. Documented personnel that were instrumental in both these tasks included the 15 aforementioned as well as the following 61 volunteers and board members.

As you can see the list is extensive however not all encompassing. I believe these fine volunteers need and deserve a moment of recognition and at the end of my submission I will list others that also contributed (post the history book) and equally deserve a moment of acknowledgement. I also welcome additions which may have been overlooked albeit not intentional.

The end of the history book brings us to the beginning of a new but darker chapter of the Willow Bunch Golf Course. During the turn of the millennium the current board of that day led by our current Mayor Joyal found themselves riddled in debt with a bleak outcome on the horizon. Collectively that board negotiated an unprecedented resolve to the situation with their current lender at the time (CIBC) to accept repayment of the debt at a mere \$0.10 on the dollar.

In order to continue operations and pay off various debts and leases they were successful in procuring financing from Conexus Credit Union with one major caveat. Collateral would be necessary over and above what little assets they had remaining to secure the loan.

At that point the president and vice president approached and lobbied the Park Board, Town Council and RM of Willow Bunch #42 Council to obtain a separate title for the purpose of using it for collateral with Conexus Credit Union with the promise/intention that "the land will be returned to the Park when the loan is paid". January 15, 2004 letter to Saskatchewan Environment.

That brings us to today's current unfortunate issue, whereby the loan has been repaid and the existing Golf Board, as listed on its most current (February 2021) ISC registered documents (8) comprising of:

have clearly indicated to the Park Board at a special meeting (9) on February 10, 2021 that they are not willing to validate the 2004 Agreement.

I too along with the opinion of the Legal Counsel you have before you find it very unfortunate that Golf Club would be willing to dishonour the agreement.

As such please ensure whatever actions you must be pursuing are well documented, (10), (11), (12) clear, concise and to the point with respect to a direction. We are very fortunate to have documents far reaching 60 years into our past outlining the process and public involvement ensuring the public would have public land to enjoy for centuries to come. It was never the intention of our forefathers and foremothers to have these lands in private control, as it was never our intentions to ever let this agreement go on without being honoured and fulfilled.

- Note the agreement called for the transfer of 13-14 acres, R.M. motion stipulated nothing, Town motion stipulate the golf course. Willow Bunch Golf Course Inc has title to 136 acres. JLLPark Authority has title to 127 acres not including CNR Dam and Town pool. (13), (14)
- Golf Course is still within the Park Boundaries, although Dominique Clincke at the Ministry indicated there was documentation on file to remove it earlier on and it's since been abandoned.
- Taxes have not been assessed to the property and as such have never been abated. Administration was notified February 22, 2021 that this needs to be corrected.
- An agreement could be drafted allowing the Golf Course Board to operate as usual for a predetermined time suitable to all parties involved.
- Park Board, Town of Willow Bunch and RM of Willow Bunch are not interested in taking over the golf course, Auto Lotto, or anything to do with operating the entity. We just want the agreement honoured.

As promised earlier, I believe it's important to acknowledge individuals who have unselfishly given of their time to serve on the Park Authority in many capacities. Please

help by filling this list and having this report form part of official meeting minutes to be preserved for years to come.

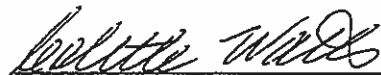

R E C I N A, MONDAY, July 24, 1961.

The Executive Council has had under consideration a report from the Minister of Natural Resources, dated July 18, 1961, stating that:

1. under the provisions of The Regional Parks Act, 1960, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may grant such financial assistance as may be deemed expedient for the purpose of enabling municipalities under that Act to establish a regional park, and may constitute a regional park authority consisting of representatives appointed by the municipalities to which such assistance is granted, which shall be a body corporate with such powers and duties as may be required;

2. two participating municipalities have entered into an agreement in the form hereto attached under The Regional Parks Act, 1960, for the purpose of establishing and operating a regional park in the vicinity of Willow Bunch in the Province of Saskatchewan, to be known as "Jean Louis Lógaró Regional Park", and have applied for assistance under the said Act for that purpose;

3. the two participating municipalities have appointed the persons hereinafter named as their representatives and requested that they be constituted a regional park authority under The Regional Parks Act, 1960, to be known as "Jean Louis Lógaró Regional Park Authority", with necessary powers to act on behalf of the said municipalities in order to establish and operate the said regional park;

4. it is deemed advisable and in the public interest to grant financial assistance in amounts to be determined by future Order in Council and to constitute the said representatives as a regional park authority.

Upon consideration of the foregoing report and on the recommendation of the Minister of Natural Resources, the Executive Council advises that His Honour's Order do issue, effective on and after the date hereof, pursuant to The Regional Parks Act, 1960, granting financial assistance in amounts to be determined by future Order in Council and constituting the persons hereinafter named a regional park authority to be known as "Jean Louis Légaré Regional Park Authority", with necessary powers to act on behalf of the participating municipalities in order to establish and operate a regional park in the vicinity of Willow Bunch in the Province of Saskatchewan, to be known as "Jean Louis Légaré Regional Park", the names of the persons so constituting Jean Louis Légaré Regional Park Authority to be as follows:

The Regional Parks Act, 1979 provides that the Minister may alter the boundaries of a regional park upon request of the Regional Park Authority. This memo covers such a request from the Jean Louis Legare Regional Park Authority to address removal of the golf course land. The park owns all land that forms the regional park.

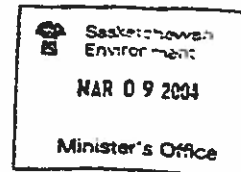
It is proposed that the golf course land be removed from the regional park and turned over to the Willow Bunch Golf Club who currently operates the golf course. This would allow the golf club to obtain separate title for the purpose of obtaining financing from the local credit union. The Regional Park Authority is not interested in securing this funding for the golf course, but is willing to transfer the golf course land to the golf club. We have received confirmation from the two participating municipalities agreeing to this request.

It is intended that the land will be transferred back to the Regional Park Authority once the golf club loan has been repaid.

Hello Sharleine,

This is further to my telephone conversation with Pat Therrien, *Wynne Joyal* and Albert Lavallee.

I recommend that the Regional Park Authority send a letter to Willow Bunch Golf Club Inc. confirming that the Park Authority understands the loan which was secured by the land previously transferred to the Golf Club has been paid back and asking for the Golf Club to transfer the land to the Park Authority as agreed upon at the time it was transferred.

I also recommend that this action be taken as soon as possible so that the resolution of this matter is not delayed.

In the event the Golf Club refuses to transfer the property back to the Park Authority then the Park Authority can bring an action in the Court of Queen's Bench seeking an order directing the Golf Club to transfer the property back to the Park Authority. In the Park Authorities letter to the Golf Club, the Park Authority could indicate that if the Golf Club is unwilling to transfer the land back to the Park Authority then the Park Authority will pursue a remedy through the courts.

I find it unfortunate that the Golf Club would be willing to dishonour the agreement which led to the transfer of the land to the Golf Club in the first place. Hopefully the Golf Club will recognize the position it is taking and the embarrassment it may cause to be reneging on the agreement and this can be resolved without resort to the courts. However, if the Park Authority cannot get the Golf Club to transfer the land back to the Park Authority then the Park Authority will have to rely on the courts to provide that remedy.

I trust you will find the above satisfactory but if you have any other question just let me know.

Hello Patrick,

This is in response to your email of February 21, 2021.

I am in the office all day today and have the flexibility to speak with you to discuss any further questions you might have. You did not provide me with a phone number to call so feel free to give me a call at the number below.

With respect to my opinion as to the actual ownership of land which is owned by a regional park authority, I will refer you to the provisions of The Regional Parks Act, 2013 ("the Act"). As a starting point, section 8 sets out how a regional park authority is to be constituted and what land is to be including in the regional park. Please note, section 8 also describes what the membership of the regional park authority is to be. Were you able to find a regional park bylaw that has been enacted with respect to the members-at-large?

Additional land may be added to a regional park pursuant to section 10 of the Act.

The section of the Act that most likely answers your question is 24. I have reproduced it below:

24(1) No land acquired by a regional park authority by purchase, lease or gift is to be withdrawn or sold from the area designated as a regional park without the consent of:

- (a) the minister; and
 - (b) subject to subsection (3), the municipalities and organizations that are represented on the regional park authority.
- (2) The owner of land within the boundaries of a regional park may recommend to the regional park authority and the minister that the land be removed from the regional park.
- (3) The minister may, by order, remove the lands from the regional park if the minister is satisfied that lands acquired by a regional park authority:
- (a) are not being used appropriately; or
 - (b) are no longer required for the purposes of the regional park.

The regional park authority cannot sell land without the consent of the minister and the municipalities which are represented on the regional park authority. Please note, this is subject to subsection (3) which allows the minister to order that lands be removed from the regional park under certain conditions.

Finally, please note section 26 of the Act which makes it clear that the regional park authority is responsible for the operation of the regional park and that no action lies or shall be commenced against any municipality represented on the regional park authority.

I trust you will find the above information to be of some assistance but if you have any other questions just let me know.

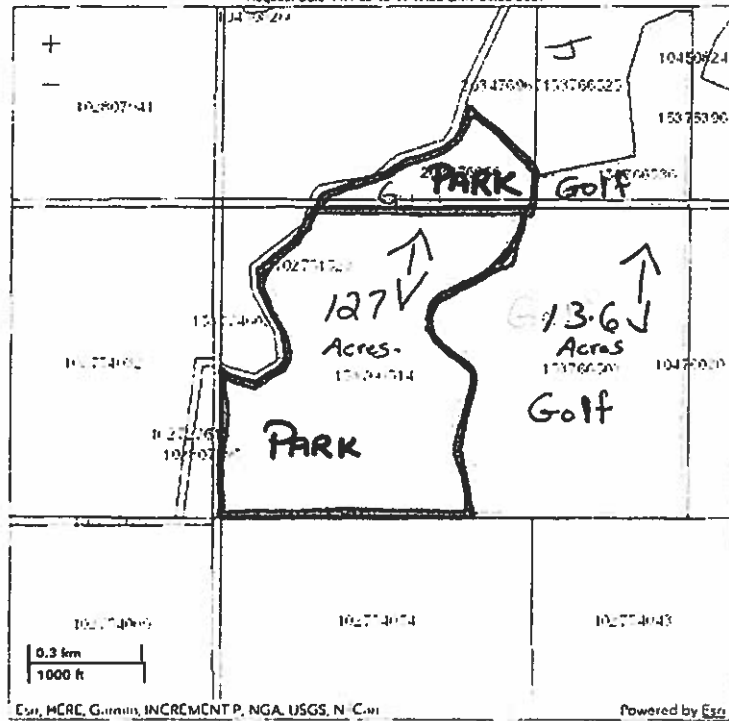

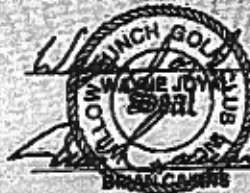

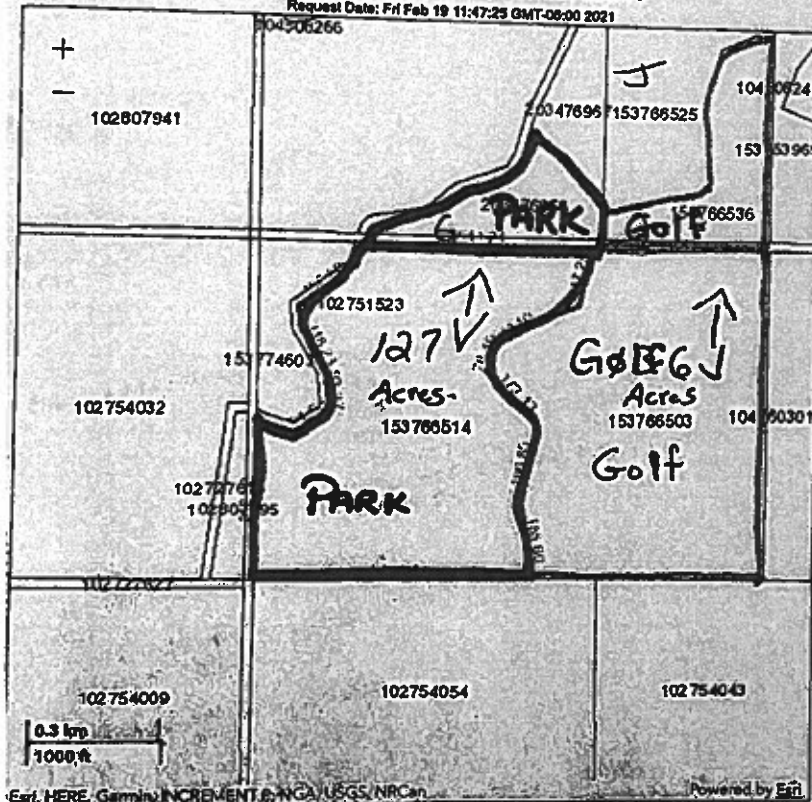

The sole purpose of this short-term transaction was utilization of the land as collateral to secure a loan from the Credit Union in Assiniboia, SK for the Willow Bunch Golf Club.

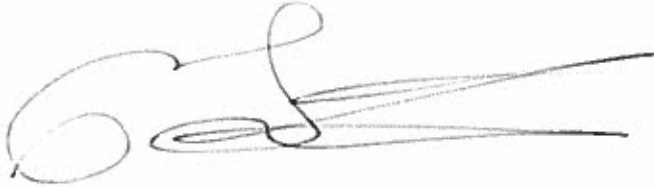

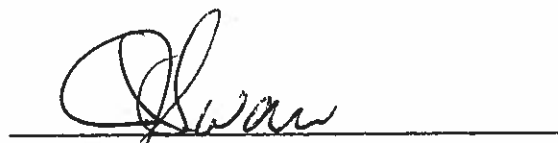
